Make.org firmly believes in democracy as a political system.

Make.org is independent of any political, economic or government organisation.



# Level of e-participation

E-enabling

Supporting those who would not typically access the internet and take advantage of the large amount of information available.

E-engaging

Supporting active participation and

deliberative debate on policy issues

Consulting a wider audience to enable deeper contributions and support

E-empowering

Supporting active participation and facilitating bottom-up ideas

# **Grand Débat** *France*

"At the initiative of the President of the Republic, the Government launched a Great National Debate to allow everyone to discuss issues that are essential to the French people."

# Conference on the Future of Europe European Union

"The Conference on the Future of Europe is a unique and timely opportunity for European citizens to debate on Europe's challenges and priorities."

# **Ireland's Convention on the Constitution** *Ireland*

"The Convention on the Constitution was established by resolution of both Houses of the Oireachtas in 2012 to consider a number of possible changes to the Constitution and make recommendations."

#### Bürgerrat Klima Germany

"The Citizens' Climate Council brought together 160 randomly selected citizens to discuss how compliance with Germany's climate protection goals."










# Analyzing and sharing results

At the end of the consultation, our study team, composed of sociologists and data scientists, analyzes the results and creates a report. We then provide support in sharing the results with citizens and ensuring that an impact is made.



#### Analysis: involvement mapping:

- Analysis of the most supported or controversial proposals to create a mapping of top consensuses, controversies and rejections based on citizens' proposals and votes, using NLP technologies and sociologists' expertise to group the proposals into clusters.
- Detailed final report including the major lessons learned, a global view on proposal topics and the mapping of consensuses and controversies

#### Sharing results

#### Presentation to partners

Oral presentation
Thematic exploration of the results to go into more detail
List of all proposals

#### Feedback to participants

**Sharing results** with all stakeholders involved: we can provide support in organizing an event
